Greetings from the Parish Office:

Our cover photo this week is our Annunciation window! The Sunday we observe Divine Mercy Sunday and on Monday the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. The later is usually observed on March 25 (9 months to the day before Christmas Day), but this year as the 25th fell during Holy Week, the Solemnity was transferred to the next available day out of the Octave which happens to be April 8. These 2 great feasts are intertwined as both manifest the great Mercy of God and illustrate the response God wants from us as we encounter His Mercy— simple, trusting faith. Not a faith that is anxious, fretful or impatient, nor with the kind of a faith that seeks to excuses ourselves from all activity. God calls us to respond with humility, trust, prayer, joy and obedience to His commandments— all of which do require an effort on our part. Our Blessed Mother Mary teaches that the just response to Divine Mercy is an affirmation done in prayer and wholesome duty done in joy.
