Greetings from the Parish Office!

This week's cover photo depicts the Apparition of Our Lady of Lourdes to Bernadette Soubirous. This occurred on February 11, 1858 in Lourdes, France. Bernadette was only 14 years old when she along with her sister and a friend were out gathering firewood about a mile from town. Suddenly a "beautiful lady" appeared to her dressed in white and wearing a blue sash and a yellow rose on each foot. This Lady carried a golden rosary. She introduced herself to Bernadette as the "Immaculate Conception" and asked that a church be built on the site of a healing spring that suddenly gushed from the ground. The Lady encouraged the recitation of the rosary. An interesting point, in fact, was that our Lady appeared that year with a similar pleas in at least 17 other locations around the world. She affirmed her identity at each as the Immaculate Conception, a dogma of the church declared 4 years prior by Pope Pius IX in 1854. We can consider this event with the history of St. Alphonsus Parish which was founded in 1856. The dogma was proclaimed 2 years prior and the apparition 2 years after. It was a golden time for the Catholic Church in the world and in Wheeling, and yet society was at the brink of the American Civil War. Blessings and trials walk side by side through history. Our time is no different, nor is our mission from the Blessed Mother any different than it was for Catholics in the time of St. Bernadette– pray more, build the Church, and pursue the amazing blessings that God continually sends so that others might know the reason for our joy.


