Do we think first to turn to God for our needs and desires? We celebrate Saint Scholastica on Monday, February 10. She once said to her brother, St. Benedict, "I asked you and you would not listen, so I asked God and He did listen." God is reliable!

This week's cover photo is a vintage image of Our Lady of Lourdes appearing to St. Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. This event was contemporary to the founding of this parish in 1856. Our Blessed Mother made a total of 18 appearances to Bernadette over a 6 month time span starting with the first on February 11. During the visits the Blessed Virgin Mary revealed a spring of water that provided the grace of healing, a gift that continues for visitors to this day. Our Blessed Mother under the title of Our Lady of Lourdes also encouraged the daily recitation of the rosary and confirmed the Dogma of her Immaculate Conception that had been proclaimed by Pope Pius IX on December 8, 1854.

This collection will happen typically on the first weekend of each month and will be used toward the restoration and maintenance of the more historic features of our church, especially those features that draw, educate and evangelize.
