Greetings from the Parish Office!

This week's cover photo is a photograph of the original St. Alphonsus Church which was built in 1856. This particular photograph is the oldest depiction we have of the church and was taken sometime between 1871 and 1874. We know this because the bell tower with the rose window seen in the photo was added in 1871, and the school which is not seen in this photo was built in 1874. This original church was deemed structurally unsound in 1886 and was demolished. However, this bell tower was left standing. The new church (the current building) was erected around it that same year.
