New Publication from the Holy Father

On Wednesday, October 4, Pope Francis issued a new Apostolic Exhortation on the environment, <u>Laudate Deum</u> ("Praise God") This is the second part of his 2015 Encyclical <u>Laudato Si</u> on Ecology. The following is a quote from the publication: "There is a throw away culture that is always going on. There is a lack of education to use the things that remain, to remake them, to replace them, in the order of the common use of things. And this throwaway culture also effects nature."

He is said to have been experiencing feelings of discouragement. She consoled and encouraged James in his mission. This event is considered to be the first Marian apparition.
